- II. Counseling Department: Positive Behavior Plan
  - A. Shannon Hatch, head counselor at CCMS, presented the Positive Behavior Plan. She spoke about the connection information they, as counselors, gather, evaluate, and share with the administration team and teachers, as well as the positive impact it has on student connections at CCMS. Shannon introduced information about groups run at CCMS including PEP (Personal Empowerment Program) groups, and who runs those.
